Dankworth Prize winning jazz musician and drummer, Luke Bainbridge, had already completed a BMus at the University of Birmingham when he joined the Royal Academy of Music to study for a MA in Jazz percussion.

Moving forward, Luke plans to work towards his debut album and UK tour as a band leader.
