Georgie McSherry has had a love of drama and musical theatre since a small child, taking part in many amateur dramatic productions, performing at the Edinburgh Fringe Festival as part of a Youth Theatre Company, and also being part of team who raised the funds to take a large group of performers to the festival. Her ultimate dream after all the hard work was to secure a place at one of the top three drama schools in the country.

After her first couple of auditions for drama school Georgie had to dig deep having been unsuccessful on both occasions. Through hard work she secured a place on a foundation course at Emil Dale Academy to prepare herself for the next round of auditions. She received no funding for the course and had work part-time to help pay for her course costs.

Georgie has shown great resilience, and the dedication to keep going and put in the hard work to achieve her dreams, and that is entirely consistent with the aims of the foundation.

In 2020 Georgie secured a place at the Guildford School of Acting. With the help of the grant from the Wavendon Foundation she has been able to take up her place and the feedback she has received from her tutors so far has been extremely positive.
